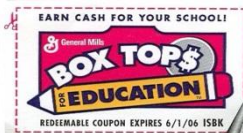

ATTN PARENTS OF 4TH GRADERS:

This year, the AIMS Science Test will be taken online by 4th graders (only 4th grade takes this particular test). Because of this, all 4th graders will require a pair of headphones or ear buds. We have a small supply to share with kiddos that do not own a pair that they can bring in, but not enough for everyone. We are asking parents to please send in ear buds or headphones (nothing fancy, no need for Beats or Skull Candy....the dollar store sells ear buds that would suffice for this particular need) during their AIMS testing week, which is the week of April 9-12. An email will come home from your classroom teacher leading up to that week, letting you know which specific day your student's class is testing. 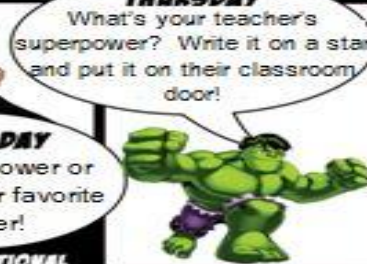
