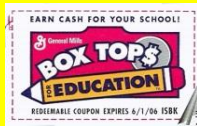

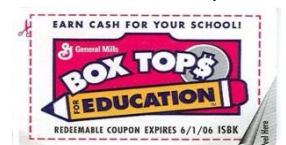

THE SAFETY PATROL IS BACK!
